## **Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request for Information**

Thank you for your request for information received on 24 January 2020 in relation to the County Durham and Darlington NHS Foundation Trust (Trust). We are dealing with your request under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested information regarding mental health. Specifically you requested information as follows:

***I have the following national figure - amongst the five broad ethnic groups, known rates of detention for the 'Black or Black British' group (306.8 detentions per 100,000 population) were over four times those of the White group (72.9 per 100,000 population).***

***I'm looking at mental health and how it's treated at a local level. I would like to know the rate and percentage of detention, seclusion and diagnosis as psychosis for all BAME groups (including those mentioned below) compared to white patients for the Trust, in 2018/2019.***
